

PCSC food accessibility project a success!

The Park County Senior Coalition has worked with PPACG and Park County Government to bring food to local seniors in Park County. We now officially have freezers stocked with frozen meals located in Guffey, Lake George, Bailey, and Fairplay. We will still continue to deliver food boxes to each community once a month but this will provide our clients with additional nutritious food if needed and allow for access to meals regardless of road closures or bad weather impacting delivery. It also allows our clients to have flexibility if they cannot make their usual delivery date work but would still like to receive food that month. This project is successfully up & running!








Senior Spotlight

Slow Cooker Taco Soup

This hearty, cozy, and boldly flavored taco soup recipe will win you over with a savory blend of chile peppers, kidney beans, ground beef, and Southwestern-inspired spices.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 (16 ounce) can chili beans, with liquid
- 1 (15 ounce) can kidney beans with liquid
- 1 (15 ounce) can whole kernel corn, with liquid
- 1 (8 ounce) can tomato sauce
- 2 cups water
- 2 (14.5 ounce) cans peeled and diced tomatoes
- 1 (4 ounce) can diced green chile peppers
- 1 (1.25 ounce) package taco seasoning mix



INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. 1.In a medium skillet, cook the ground beef until browned over medium heat. Drain, and set aside.
- 2. Place the ground beef, onion, chili beans, kidney beans, corn, tomato sauce, water, diced tomatoes, green chile peppers and taco seasoning mix in a slow cooker. Mix to blend, and cook on Low setting for 8 hours. Adjust seasoning to your taste and top with tortilla chips, cheddar cheese, sour cream, or corn bread.
